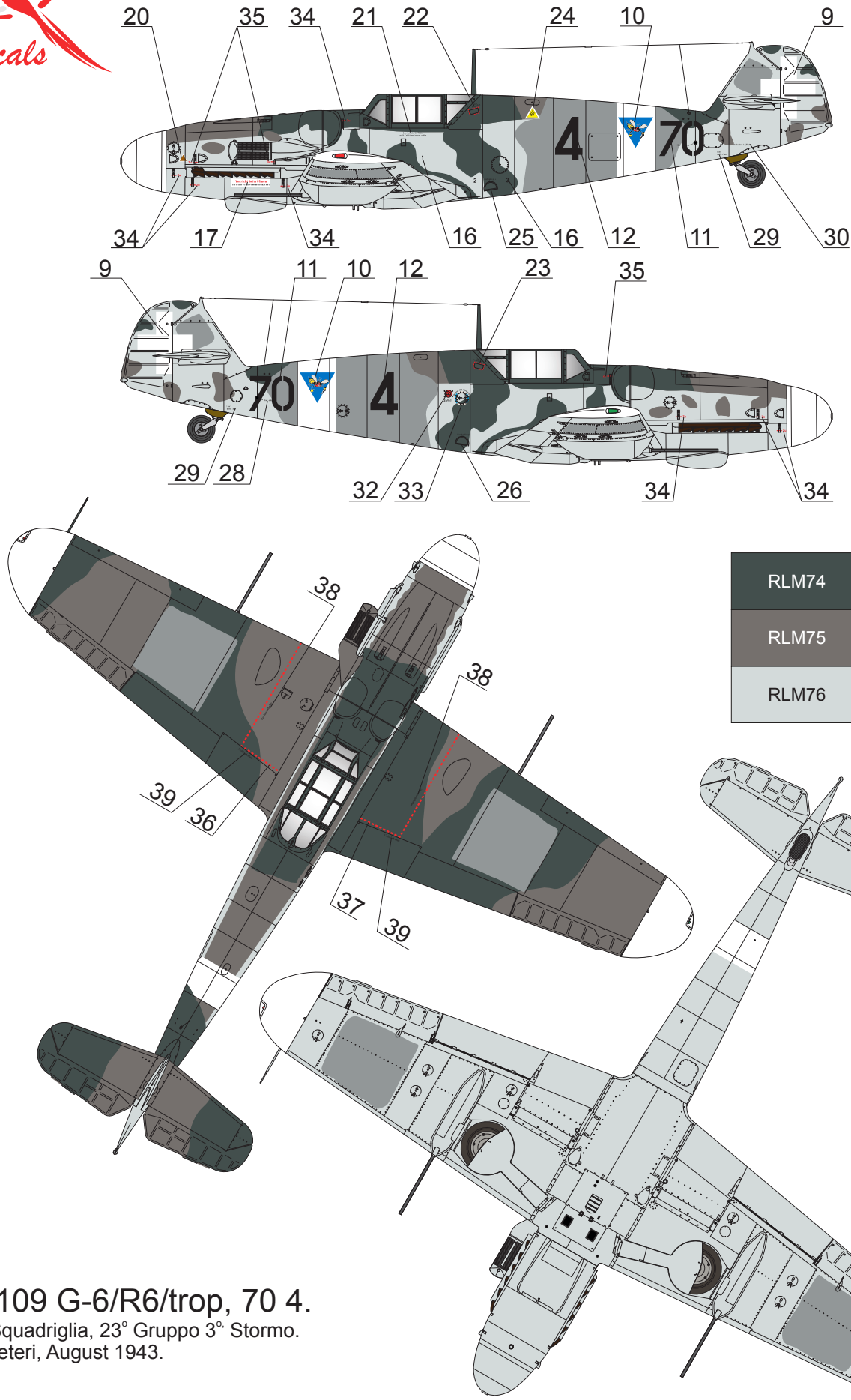


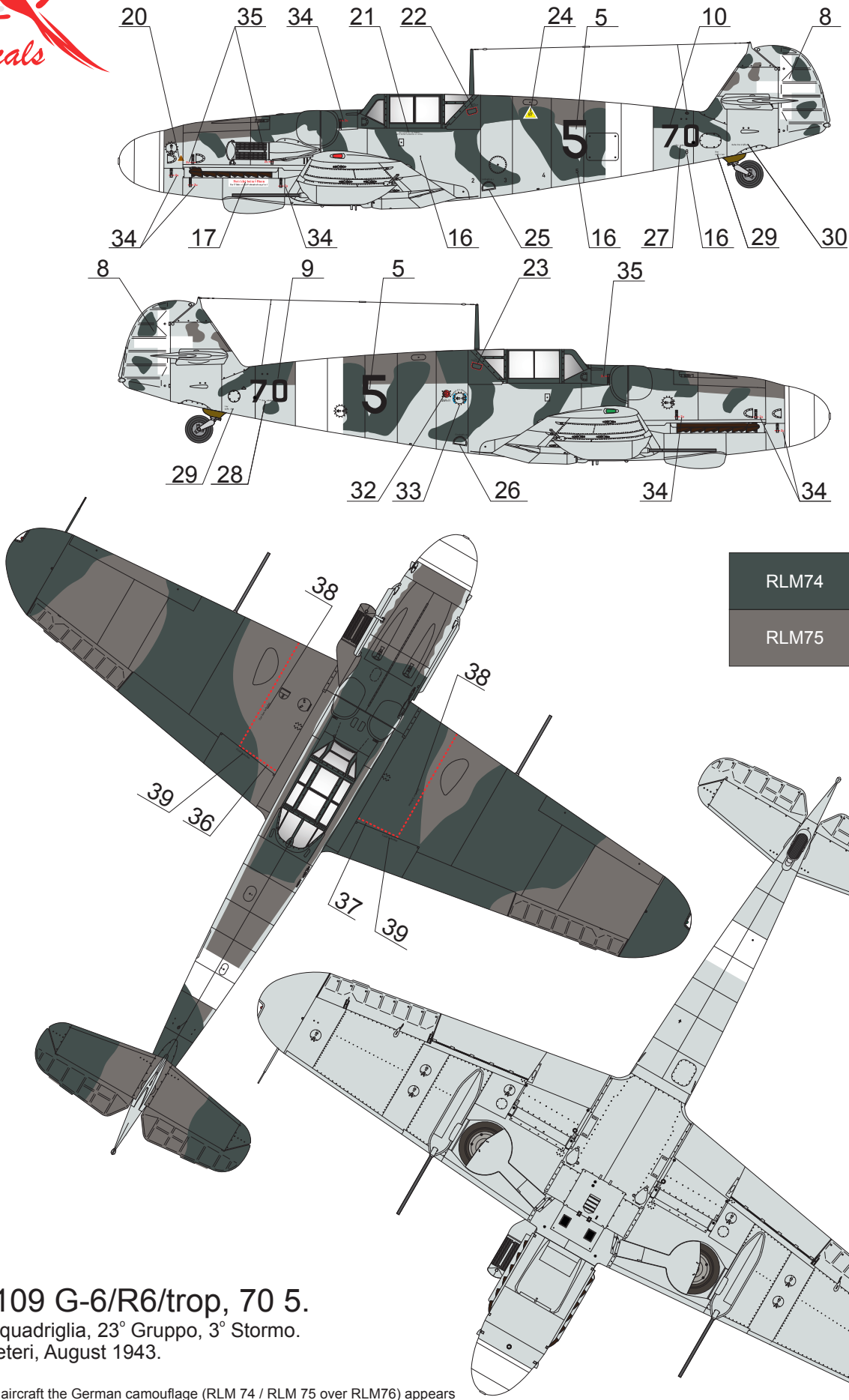
### Bf 109 G-2 Trop W.Nr.10610, 73 7.

Wholly reconstructed by book „Ali Straniere in Italia - Messerschmitt Bf 109 Italiani”  
The individual code of Tenente Giulio Reiner had been attributed wholly arbitrarily.  
This Eral-built fighter has a fixed tailwheel.

On this aircraft the German camouflage (RLM 74 / RLM 75 over RLM76) appears intact, as if the Gustav had been delivered without *Luftwaffe* insignia or had been completely repainted in the original factory colours. The Savoy cross on the tail is thinner than usual; in addition, there are no wing fasces, in accordance with the abolition of Fascism decreed by the Badoglio government after the deposition of Mussolini.
